## Outcomes of Intensive Research Abroad through EuroScholars

### Program Details

- Intensive, research-oriented semester or academic year at one of nine prestigious universities in Europe
- Each semester of study is transcribed by the host university in Europe and is considered full-time study
- All research and deliverables are conducted in English
- A culture and language course is provided at each university
- Mid-stay program allows students to network, experience a new city, and present their research findings to date
- Projects are available in all disciplines: STEM fields, humanities, social sciences, business & finance, etc.
- Geared toward bright and independent students with strong interest in research; 3.4 GPA or higher required
- Program deadlines are April 1 for fall semester or academic year and October 1 for spring semester
