

PTSD affects many people in Europe and in the World

Around 7.7 million people in Europe Around 318 million people in the world

Current PTSD Treatments

They only reach full effectiveness in a subset of patients: 50-60%

Cogntitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) Exposure Therapy Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors (SSRIs)

Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR)


The Use of Tetris




