Due to the COVID-19 situation worldwide, the EuroScholars students who participated during the Spring 2020 semester had been instructed or strongly advised to return home by their home university.

During this semester, all students were offered to conduct their, in some cases, alternative research remotely and to part take in their language course and/or elective course and exam(s) and still earn their credits.

EuroScholars Program cancelled for Fall 2020 intake

In the meantime, the measures taken by the respective countries are changing frequently, the EuroScholars Board and Consortium decided, that due to the unpredictability of the COVID-19 to cancel the program for the Fall 2020 intake for all their locations. Prospective students who had

already been admitted or whose application was being reviewed have been offered to transfer their application to the next semester.

Although the program has been cancelled for the Fall 2020 intake, EuroScholars universities are once again open for business and plan to re-engage in their normal education and research programming in the new academic year as much as possible. The EuroScholars Consortium continues to operate under the premise that for the Spring 2021 semester the Consortium can move back into their regular EuroScholars operations.

University of Zurich withdrawing from EuroScholars Consortium

With much regret, we have to announce that after almost 12 years, the University of Zurich has decided to withdraw their participation from the EuroScholars Consortium. The University of Zurich has decided to change their university's strategic plans for internationalization and will therefore not offer any placements within the EuroScholars Program as per the Fall 2020 semester.

KU Leuven researchers shed new light on solar flares:

Plasma astrophysicists at KU Leuven have created the first self-consistent simulation of the physical processes that occur during a solar flare. The researchers used Flemish supercomputers and a new combination of physical models.

The University of Geneva offers more than 500 programmes (including 136 Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes, 87 doctoral programmes) and 343 continuing education programmes covering an extremely wide variety of fields: exact sciences, medicine, humanities, social sciences, law, etc.

Its domains of excellence in research include life sciences (molecular biology, bio-informatics), physics of elementary particles, and astrophysics. UNIGE is also host and co-host to seven National Centres of Competence in Research: Frontiers in Genetics, MaNEP, PlanetS, SwissMap, Chemical Biology, Synaptic Bases of Mental Diseases and LIVES-Overcoming vulnerabilities in a life course perspective.

The brain has a high energy demand and reacts very sensitively to oxygen deficiency. LMU neurobiologists have now succeeded for the first time in directly correlating oxygen consumption with the activity of certain nerve cells.

Ivan Huc's specialty might best be termed molecular mimicry. He designs and builds synthetic analogs of biomolecules that retain the essential features of their models, while exhibiting properties beyond those seen in nature.
